2 foundation courses, 1 core course, 4 optional courses; 5 core or optional courses from 0.3

0.5 Translation Studies

2 foundational courses, 5 core courses; 5 core or optional courses from 0.1

0.6 Interpretation

2 foundational courses, 2-3 core courses; 7-8 core or optional courses from 0.3

0.8 Intercultural Communication

2 foundational courses, 2-3 core courses; 3-4 optional courses; 3-5 core or optional courses from 0.1 or 0.3
